2. Mayor's Report
 - a. No report from Mayor Schmitt. He was unable to attend meeting.
3. Updates from District Police Captains
 - a. Captain John Laux from District C, Captain Keith Knoebel from District B, and Captain Kevin Warych from District D introduced themselves and spoke about crime statistics and other issues in their designated areas.
4. Historic Preservation Commission
 - a. Presentation by Alderman Mark Steuer and Jacqueline Frank about Green Bay obtaining Certified Local Government status in order to encourage and assist in historic preservation. The HPC works with homeowners to review design and property changes to currently registered historic homes. Tax credits are also available to assist in repairs and improvements to registered historic homes. The Commission meets every 2nd Monday, 4pm, at City Hall, 100 N Jefferson Street.
 - b. Ald. Steuer will be doing a presentation entitled Architecture, Planning and Politics at the Neville Museum on July 14th at 7pm. The presentation is free of charge. There will be a walk on Broadway after the event.
