Since a year has passed since the GBNLC awarded the artist \$5000 to complete the project, the artist retracted his grant application. The artist stated there has been difficulty securing a location for the project. Discussion ensued with questions raised by GBNLC members. A motion was made by Dan Theno that the GBNLC support a Green Bay Location for Pedro The Pelican next to the Northland Hotel. Motion was seconded by Joe Rabideau. Cheryl Renier-Wigg motioned to amend the motion to expand the location from just the Northland to “Downtown Green Bay”. Amendment was accepted by Dan Theno and Joe Rabideau. Amendment was accepted. The new motion reads, The GBNLC communicate to City Hall, its officials, and elected officials that we endorse the Pedro The Pelican project in a Downtown location and that we want to see that project move forward in our community. The motion passed unanimously.
